Ngorongoro 1-Day Safari (Long transfer time)

Ngorongoro Crater safari is significantly more expensive than Arusha, Manyara and Tarangire due to the \$295 van fee.

Day 0 - You arrive in Arusha

Day 1: Your guide will pick you up from your accommodation at 07:30. The journey to Ngorongoro from Arusha is a scenic but long journey taking 4 and 3 quarter hours each way. On route, you will experience a variety of scenic and vegetation changes, Maasai grazing their cattle along the roadside. From the Ngorongoro RIm you will be treated to a stunning landscape as you look down into the crater. Within the crater the experience of being within an enclosed extinct volcanic crater is awe inspiring.

Ngorongoro is a world UNESCO heritage site, located 180 km west of Arusha in the Crater Highlands area of Tanzania. The area is named after Ngorongoro Crater, a large volcanic caldera within the area. The Ngorongoro Crater and surrounding highlands together form one of Africa's most beautiful regions. Volcanic craters form stunning backdrops to some of the most fertile and richest grazing grounds in Africa. It is home to the highest density of big game in Africa, including four of the big five and plenty of predators. Ngorongoro is justifiably one of the continent's most famous safari destinations. It is the best place in Tanzania to see 'The big five', and the only place to see the black rhino along with some of the largest tusker elephants left in Africa.

Following a box picnic lunch, you will enjoy a short afternoon game drive, after which you will transfer back to Arusha by 6:30pm.
