# **Natural History Explorer**

(Best Migration Season in Lake Ndutu: Dec - June)

## Wildebeest, Wildebeest! 1 Day Lake Ndutu, 2 Days Serengeti, 1 Day Ngorongoro

The great wildebeest migration is the movement of vast number of the Serengeti's wildebeest accompanied by large numbers of zebra and smaller numbers of Graant's gazelle, Thompson's gazelle, eland and impala. These ungulates migrate throughout the year, constantly seeking fresh grazing and water. The precise timing of the Serengeti wildebeest migration is entirely dependent upon the rainfall pattern.

Feel the warm African breeze, hear the distant roar of a lion, the trumpeting of elephants, and the chattering of monkeys, as you journey through Tanzania's National Wildlife Parks, on the Safari of a lifetime. Visit the Serengeti planes and experience the wildebeest migration, watch the sunset, to the

musical sound of crickets, and indulge yourself in the taste of local cuisine. Sleep soundly at night in a comfortable bed with to the sound of wildlife.

## **Overview**

Day 0 - You arrive in Arusha. We pick you up from airport and transfer you to Accommodation in Arusha Korona House (or similar).

Or we pick you up from airport in morning of day 1

Day 1 – Drive to Lake Ndutu overnight in Karatu at campsite.

Day 2 – Drive through Ngorongoro Conservation area to Serengeti arriving early afternoon for game drive. Picnic lunch on route. Dinner and overnight at Seronera campsite.

Dav 3 – Serengeti Full Dav Game Drive.

Day 4 – Following breakfast: Full day Game Drive in Serengeti with picnic lunch. Transfer back through Ngorongoro Conservancy Area to accommodation at Simba Campsite.

Day 5 - Breakfast, Proceed to Ngorongoro crater for game drive with picnic lunch. Return to Arusha.

#### Day 1: Arusha to Lake Ndutu, Ngorongoro

Your guide will pick you up from your accommodation in Arusha at 07:30. The journey to the Serengeti will pass through Mtu Wa Mbu. On-route, you will experience a variety of colourful scenic and vegetation changes, with Maasai tending to their grazing cattle, and goats, along the roadside. As you ascend the Ngorongoro Rim you will stop at the spectacular Lake Manyara view point. Your journey continues through the Ngorongoro Conservation area to the Serengeti, passing Maasai villages before arriving in Ndutu. The drive from Arusha takes about 6 hours. You will enjoy a game drive on-route before arriving at your evening campsite in time for dinner.

Meals: Box Lunch, Dinner

## Day 2: Drive Ndutu to Central Serengeti

Following a hearty breakfast, you will have a morning game drive in Ndutu then late afternoon start drive to Central Serengeti. The Serengeti is one of Tanzania's most famous National Parks. The migration route for thousands of Wildebeest forging through rivers, kicking up dust migrating to lush pastures. Most safaris focus on the Serenora area, the easily accessed Central Serengeti, with tree lions lazing, watchfully surveying the landscape, hippos languishing in the cool river waters, cheetah, Thompson, grant gazelle, zebra, elephant are seen in this beautiful Serengeti. The occasional hot-air balloon can be seen drifting overhead, gently skimming the grasslands in search of the perfect wildlife experience.

Day 3: Serengeti Full Day Game Drive

# Day 4: Serengeti to Ngorongoro Rim

Early morning game drive. Return for breakfast, then morning game drive, during which you will likely see lions lounging in trees or on the kopje (rocky out crops), watch Hippo's lazily wallow in the river while you enjoy a Box Lunch. Transfer to Ngorongoro Conservation area, stop at a magnificent viewpoint before continuing to your evening accommodation and dinner.

Accommodation: Simba Campsite

Meals: Breakfast, Box Lunch

# Day 5: Ngorongoro Crater and return to Arusha

Descending to the crater floor of this extinct volcano, for a full day's game drive. Ngorongoro is a world UNESCO heritage site, in which wildlife and pastoral Maasai exist alongside one another. In this stunningly beautiful area your guide will seek out the best locations for you to see 'the big five', and if you are very lucky a rare black rhino. Late afternoon you will be driven back to Arusha, arriving at your accommodation around 6pm.
